VISAS REQUIREMENTS



Travelers with a valid European passport, Schengen visa, a valid passport or visa of the United States, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland or a residence permit in those countries may enter and stay in or cross the territory of Montenegro up to 30 days, and not longer than the expiry of the validity of the residence permit or passport / visa.

VISAS REQUIREMENTS UNITED ARAB EMIRATES



- During the summer, when Fly Dubai operates a direct line, holders of valid foreign travel documents with a residence permit in the United Arab Emirates can enter, cross the territory and stay in Montenegro for up to 10 days without a visa, if they have a certificate on the tourist arrangement (insurance, accommodation, funds), return air ticket on the direct route United Arab Emirates Montenegro, and provided that the residence permit is valid for at least 30 days from the date of leaving Montenegro and have evidence of adequate travel history.
- **UAE citizens (locals) do not need a visa** to enter and stay in Montenegro for up to 90 days in a period of 180 days.
- During the year, except summer period, Residents of UAE need a visa for which they can apply at the Embassy of Montenegro in Abu Dhabi.

VISAS REQUIREMENTS THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA




- Visas for citizens of The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporary suspended from 1st of June till 30th of September and in that period the citizens of Saudi Arabia can stay, enter, cross the territory and stay in Montenegro for up to 30 days, with a valid travel document without a visa.
- The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia citizens (locals) with Schengen visa, United States visa and United Kingdom of Great Britain visa do not need a visa to enter and stay in Montenegro for up to 90 days in a period of 180 days. For those who don't have mentioned visas, the visa for Montenegro is required and they can apply at the Embassy of Montenegro in Abu Dhabi or in Embassy of Serbia (which, based on the agreement, covers Montenegro in the area of visa issuance) in Riyadh. Applications are accepted 90-30 days before the travel.
- Depending on other conditions defined by the Visa Regulation, residents must or may not have a visa. If they need it, they can apply at the Embassy of Montenegro in Abu Dhabi or in Embassy of Serbia (which, based on the agreement, covers Montenegro in the area of visa issuance) in Riyadh.

VISAS REQUIREMENTS INDIA



• Citizens of India need a visa when entering the territory of the Republic of Montenegro. Montenegro does not have the embassy in India, so the the citizens of India can apply for visa is in the Embassy of the Republic of Serbia in New Delhi, Republic of India

FLIGHT CONNECTIONS



In Montenegro there are two modern airports.

One in the capital city **Podgorica** (12km from the city center) and the other one in **Tivat** (4km from the city centre).

Montenegro can be reached conveniently from <u>**Dubrovnik airport</u>**, **Croatia** (15 minutes from the Montenegro border)</u>

Montenegro can be reached conveniently from <u>Tirana airport</u>, Albania (2 hours drive from the Montenegro)

From those airports Montenegro has direct connections with the most important European cities, as well as with the countries beside Europe.

Citizens of UAE can take advantage of Fly Dubai direct flights from Dubai to Montenegro which will start from the 24th of June until 10th of August.


It is very important to say that Montenegro is the only country in the Balkans that has never been fully conquered by any great empire. Throughout history Montenegrin brave warriors always maneged to



Montenegrins - the tallest people in the World!



Montenegrins are the tallest people in the world with an average height of 182.9 cm, surpassing the Dutch (182.4 cm) by half a centimeter



The tallest railway bridge in Europe Mala Rijeka



When constructed (1969 – 1973), this was the highest railway bridge in the world! It is 200m high!

It held the record until 2001 when the Beipan River Shuibai Railway Bridge, a concrete arch bridge, was completed in Guizhou in China.





The deepest canyon in Europe Tara "The last tear of Europe"











The canyon at its deepest is around 1,300 meters deep. These parameters make the Tara River Canyon the deepest river canyons in Europe. After Canyon Colorado in USA, it is the deepest canyon in the World.

The famous Đurđevića Tara bridge which is in this canyon is 172m high.



The longest sand beach on Adriatic coast Ulcinj beach







The sand beach's length is 12,000 meters (8 miles), the longest beach in Montenegro. It is the premier kitesurfing location on the Adriatic Coast The New York Times included Velika plaža and Montenegro's South Coast in a ranking of top travel destinations for 2010 - "Top Places to Go in 2010".

The first and still the only *ecological country* in the World pronounced on 20th of September 1991.

Scadar lake lies on the border of
Montenegro and Albania, and is the largest lake
in Southern Europe. The Bojana River connects
the lake with the Adriatic Sea. Lake Skadar is
the largest bird reserves in Europe, having 279
bird species, among which are some of the last
pelicans colony in Europe.

The Boka bay is the winding bay of the Adriatic Sea in southwestern Montenegro. The bay has been inhabited since antiquity. Its well-preserved medieval towns of Kotor, Risan, Tivat, Perast, Prčanj and Herceg Novi, along with their natural surroundings, are major tourist attractions. Natural and Culturo-Historical Region of Kotor has been a World Heritage Site since 1979. Its numerous Orthodox and Catholic churches and monasteries make it a major pilgrimage site.



The only hotel island in Europe







approximately 6 kilometres southeast of Budva. In the 15th century, the fortified village was built to defend against the Turks and became a haven for pirates of the Adriatic. According to a legend, the town fortification was funded after Paštrovići looted Turkish ships moored during Barbarossa's siege of Kotor in 1539. Today it is managed by Aman resort, luxury 5 stars hotel. The island is named after St. Stephen who was the first Christian martyr, one of the seven deacons chosen at the beginning of the church, according to the Parts of the Apostles.

The last virgin forest in Europe





Biogradska Gora is a forest and a national park in Montenegro within Kolašin municipality. It is located in the mountainous region of Bjelasica in the central part of Montenegro between the rivers Tara and Lim. It has great diversity of flora and fauna. The forest trees in the national park are up to 1000 years old! The landscape is one of mountain ridges, glacial lakes, and temperate forest.






The **oldest olive tree** in Europe!









The old olive tree is the European olive tree believed to be the oldest tree of its kind in Europe and one of the oldest in the world. The analysis showed that the tree is **2240** years old. It is located in the town of Bar and in 1957 it was protected by law and declared a natural monument. It is one of the most important natural resources in Montenegro. It had been burning in the fire twice in the past, but it recovered and is still born. Fruits are collected from it, and olive oil is sold to visitors to the complex.







The first state printing company in the world and the first South Slavs printed book!



In the area around Cetinje on Obod, in 1492, the first book in South Slavs was printed in 1492, only a few decades after the first book in the world. It is interesting that this book named "Oktoih" was printed in the first state printing company in the world in the year when Christopher Columbus discovered America!



MONTENEGRIN PRIDE



Jadran – training sailing boat that was built 86 years ago for the Yugoslav Royal Navy. Durig the history, this ship was under the comand of Italian navy which named it Marco Polo. After the capitulation of Italy in 1943 the ship was abandoned in Venice where it was used as the bridge in one of Venetian canals. At the request of Yugoslav government, the ship was back in Tivat, where it was restaured. Former president of Yugoslavia Josip Broz Tito loved this sailing ship and used to sail with it alongside the cost of Adriatic. Today it is still located in Tivat showing of it's beauty and pride! It represents one of the tourist attractions of the city and one of the most beautiful sailing ships in whole Europe!







MORE THAN HUNDRED YEARS OF WAR - MONTENEGRO VS JAPAN -

Interesting historical fact is the war between Montenegro and Japan, that lasted for more than 100 years! From the 1904 when the war was declared by Montenegro. We entered this war supporting Russian empire which had intentions of expanding their influence in Manchuria and Korean peninsula, as well as Japanese empire did. Although two empires did not agree and Russians rejected the Japanese offer, the war broke out!

Montenegrins not only declared war on Japan, but sent volunteers that went all the way across the globe to fight alongside Slavic brothers against the Japanese. One of the most striking events related to the Montenegro's involvement in that war, was the story about *Aleksandar Lekso Saicic*, a Montenegrin soldier who defeated a samurai in a sword fight!

Before the two armies clashed in the battle, the strange request from the Japanese General came. He demanded that before the battle, they arrange a duel between two of their champions. Montenegrin soldier stood out to fight in front of Russian army against the Japanese champion. Lekso convinced the General of Russian army that he was the right person for the duel.

The fight between Lekso and samurai took place in Eastern Manchuria, somewhere near the city of Vladivostok. After taking several serious blows, this brave Montenegrin somehow managed to defeat the samurai and this gave the psychological advantage to the Russian army.

The sword he used to kill the samurai is being kept to this day in the Russian Military Museum in Moscow.

The peace treaty between Russians and Japanese was signed in Portsmouth in 1905, but the Montenegrins did not sign it. Japanese were angry because of our brave worrior. We were still in war, but on a great distance © Year after year passed by and Japanese were living in fear that Montenegrins will strike once again! Finally, after more than 100 years, they gather courage to asked for peace treaty! After several months of "exhausting" negotiation the peace treaty between two countries was signed ©



Venetian Works Of Defence Between 16th And 17th Centuries













The coastal area around Budva, called the Budva riviera, is the center of Montenegrin tourism, known for its well-preserved medieval walled city, sandy beaches and diverse nightlife. Budva is 2,500 years old, which makes it one of the oldest settlements on the Adriatic coast.









The old Mediterranean port of Kotor is surrounded by fortifications built during the Venetian period. It is located on the Bay of Kotor (Boka Kotorska), one of the most indented parts of the Adriatic Sea. Kotor's much older, more original and more charming than most of Adriatic medieval cities. The fortified city of Kotor was also included in UNESCO's World Heritage Site list as part of Venetian Works of Defence between 15th and 17th centuries: Stato da Terra – western Stato da Mar in 2017. San Giovani fortress is above the city wit h more than 1400 stairs to climb to get to it.





PERAST



Perast is an old town on the Bay of Kotor in Montenegro. It is situated a few kilometres northwest of Kotor and is noted for its proximity to the islets of St. George and Our Lady of the Rocks. The first memories of Perast refer to 1336 - at that time there was a small fishing village, which had a shipyard with the fleet of over 100 sailing ships! This town was famous in the past for it's sailors whose glory was well known worldwide.



HERCEG NOVI



Herceg Novi is a coastal town in Montenegro located at the entrance to the Bay of Kotor and at the foot of Mount Orjen. Herceg Novi was known as Castelnuovo ("New castle" in Italian) between 1482 and 1797, when it was part of Ottoman Empire and the Albania Veneta of the Republic of Venice.. Herceg Novi has had a turbulent past, despite being one of the youngest settlements on the Adriatic.








ULCINJ






Ulcinj Old Town is an ancient castle and neighborhood in Ulcinj, Montenegro. It is one of the oldest town in Adriatic! It was built by the Illyrians and Ancient Greeks on a small peninsula at the right side of the Pristan Gulf, which is part of the Adriatic Sea. Back in the past, city was one of the most famous pirate base in the Mediterranean and its name was "Dolcinium". According to the legend in the end of the XVI century the well-known Spanish writer Miguel de Cervantes was a slave in Ulcinj and it is believed that this city inspired him to write his famous novel Don Kixote. HE named the main female character in the novel Dulcinea of Tobos, after the name of the city he was in slavory.





BAR OLD TOWN




Located about 4 km outside today's Bar, it is laying on a large rock and is protected by cliffs on three sides and by ramparts walls along the west side. The town hosts remains of 240 buildings in ruins with narrow winding streets and irregular-shape squares. Bar is the only city which has sea, mountains and lake! In this city is multniethnical sociaty where three religions are combined, with people living for centuries in peace and harmony.





CETINJE - OLD ROYAL CAPITAL



Cetinje, little mountainous town, became the official capital of Montenegro and became the place where even 12 different embassies were opened back in the 19th century. Still today, beside the former embassies, this is the place where many other impressive buildings are standing such as Cetinje monastery, the keeper of spiritual and cultural treasures, former Government House, Theater Zetski dom, Biljarda – the residence of Montenegrin rulers, and Palace of King Nikola, reminding every visitor about glorious history of this Balkan country! On Cetinje are located the particles of The Holy Cross, on which Jesus was crucified, the right hand of John the Baptist and the Filerma icon of the Mother of God, painted by the Apostle Luke as well as the relics of St Peter of Cetinje.










NJEGUŠI AND MAUSOLEUM







Njeguši is a village within Cetinje municipality located on the slopes of Mount Lovćen, within Lovćen national park at 1,111 meter above sea level. This village is best known as birthplace of Montenegro's royal dynasty of Petrović, which ruled Montenegro from 1696 to 1918. Njeguški sir and Njeguški pršut, local forms of cheese and prosciutto respectively, made solely in area around Njeguši, are genuine contributions to Montenegrin cuisine. Exactly 461 stairs lead to Jezerski Vrh, peak of the Lovcen, which is located at an altitude of 1660 m above sea level, where the Mausoleum dedicated to Petar II Petrovic Njegos was opened in 1974, making it the mausoleum at the highest altitude in the world at the time.



ŽABLJAK CRNOJEVIĆA



Žabljak Crnojevića is an abandoned medieval fortified town in Montenegro. The fortress itself is located on the confluence of the Morača river in the Skadarsko Jezero. It is believed that this fortress was founded in the tenth century during the reign of the Vojislavljević dynasty in then-known Duklja, whereas the first known written testimony of the fortress originate from mid-fifteenth century.

RIJEKA CRNOJEVIĆA



Rijeka Crnojevica one beautiful small historical place, in Central part of Montenegro. In ancient time was an important trading route through Montenegro. Rijeka Crnojevica is located near the most beautiful part of Lake Skadar. The whole surrounding area is spectacular. There is an beautiful old bridge that was used for the trade route, that is very impressive and worth to visit.

You can hike from Rijeka Crnojevica to Virpazar or other nearby places, or just borrow a canoe for couple of euros and enjoy on a amazing lake tour.

VIRPAZAR



Virpazar is a small place on Lake Skadar, with many attractions and tourist activities and a great starting point for many hiking tours.

One of the main offer for tourists is a boat ride on Lake Skadar. In recent years, more and more tourists are going to the stunning *Bird Watching tours*. The dishes and excellent wines are offered in local restaurants and surrouning area is famous for the best red wine producers in whole country.

HUSSEIN PASHA'S MOSQUE

Hussein Pasha's mosque, in Pljevlja, is one of the most valuable monuments of oriental culture in the Balkans. Construction began around 1570. The minaret of this mosque is the largest in the Balkans, 42 meters high, and on its floor is still the original carpet from 1573, made in Egypt to fit the measures of this building, sewn with leather and weighing about 400 kilograms. In addition to old manuscripts in Arabic and Turkish, the mosque houses a manuscript of the Koran, from 1571, in a leather cover, with 233 leaves, made by order of Hussein Pasha Boljanic.











THE CATHEDRAL OF SAINT TRYPHON






The Cathedral of Saint Tryphon in Kotor is the spiritual symbol of the town. It is one of two Roman Catholic cathedrals in Montenegro. It is the seat of the Catholic Bishopric of Kotor which covers the entire gulf. Located in the very heart of the old town of Kotor, it is one of Kotor's most recognizable structures. Dating back to the far past (809), this regal structure was built in honor of the city's patron saint and protector, St Tryphon.





OSTROG MONASTERY



The Monastery of Ostrog is a monastery of Orthodox Church situated against an almost vertical background, high up in the large rock of Ostroška Greda, in Montenegro. It is dedicated to Saint Basil of Ostrog (Sveti Vasilije Ostroški), who was buried here. The monastery is located 50 km from Podgorica and 15 km from Nikšić. Ostrog monastery is the most popular pilgrimage place in Montenegro.
